In the what's going on at church column ... Ash Wednesday is just around the corner ... As I mentioned in last month's newsletter, Ash Wednesday falls on March 5 and our service begins at 7:00 PM.

Join us for a service of confession and absolution and the imposition of ashes. This evening service is different than any other Ash Wednesday service I've seen. It's based on the Ten Commandments as explained by Martin Luther in his Small Catechism, and it's become one of my favorite services of the year.

The rest of Lent sees the return of midweek Lenten suppers which will begin at 6:00 PM each of the five Wednesdays in Lent starting with March 12. The meals will be provided and served by the youth of Zion and your offering will go toward the activities of the Youth Group.

Another twist is that we will have something a little different to go along with these suppers. Instead of a worship service to follow the supper we will be presenting a five-part Lenten drama. It will be sort of like a dinner theater - for lack of a better term I think we'll go with that as the description - a Lenten Dinner Theater! Both the meal and the drama will be presented in the fellowship hall area of the education building.

The drama is actually a lot of fun and is of course educational. Each week focuses on a different major element of Christian Worship. On the surface, the dramas convey a simple fairy-tale like story - so they will be fun for all ages, but on a deeper level they address the biblical themes that underlie Christian Worship.

You and your friends and neighbors are welcome to join us for any and all of these worship and fellowship opportunities throughout the season of Lent.
